

## **II CONFERENCE OF THE STATES PARTIES TO THE PACT OF SAN JOSE FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE SIDH**

1. - Create a Special Committee of Ministers of Foreign Affairs, to visits the countries that are not part of the American Convention on Human Rights. The Special Committee shall be composed of the Ministers of Foreign Affairs representing South America (Uruguay), Caribbean (Haiti) Central America (pending) and North America (pending). At the same time, the Committee of Ministers will hold a forum of States Parties and States not Party to participate in the civil society and other stakeholders to strengthen and promote the universality of the system. The Ministers will inform about the Third Meeting of States Parties.

2.- Progress in the consideration of the convenience to change the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights (IACHR) headquarters' , to be located in a State Party to the American Convention on Human Rights, through the creation of an open-ended Working Group, led by Uruguay and Ecuador to identify budgetary challenges, regulatory and functional of this transfer, among others, as well as the impact on smaller countries, and to report at the Third Conference of States Parties to the American Convention on Human Rights.

3.- Propose to the OAS General Assembly to instruct the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights, incorporated into its Strategic Plan, a Guide for the Promotion of Human Rights to include outreach events on national practices of all States.

4.- To request the Secretary General of the Organization of American States (OAS) to present to the Permanent Council the analysis, detailed funding sources, operating costs of the Inter-American System of Human Rights as soon as possible.

5.- Instruct Ecuador and Bolivia the necessary coordination with the States Parties, for the organization of the Third Conference of States Parties to the American Convention on Human Rights.
